CODE OF CONDUCT

STOCKTON ROWING TEAM RULES:

The following team rules are a supplement to US Rowing, SWJRA and SIF policies, regulations and procedures. Each team member should read, understand and follow each of these policies, regulations and procedures during the entire spring and fall rowing seasons and academic year.

In addition to the RiverPoint Landing Marina-Resort rules, the following items apply to all Stockton Rowing Club Junior Athletes during SRC events, practices, races, functions, etc. Failure to comply with any of these guidelines may result in suspension or expulsion from SRC with forfeiture of dues, fees or deposits.

- First and foremost, remember that you are representing the club whenever you are involved with any SRC activity. If you wouldn't do it in front of your coach or parents, don't do it in public as a representative of the club. Represent your team with pride at all times.
- Respect the SRC boathouse. Keep the boathouse as well as the surrounding area clean and orderly, and take any personal gear home. Respect others personal property.
- Be punctual for practice and crew functions. Contact your coach immediately if you will miss practice.
- Abuse of equipment will not be tolerated. Report any damaged equipment immediately.
- Be courteous and respectful to teammates, opponents, coaching staff, other club members and other tenants of RiverPoint Marina.
- Use of any illegal substances (drugs) or consumption of alcohol will result in expulsion.
- No swearing or inappropriate gestures. Horseplay in the boathouse or in/on vehicles is prohibited.
- Physical assault of any type is prohibited.
- Weapons or firearms are prohibited.
- No one shall use social media as a venue to denigrate, harass or negatively comment on any teammate, coach, parent or SRC member.
- Bullying, harassment and hazing by any one is strictly prohibited.
- Boyfriend - girlfriend relationships are to left at home. They will not be tolerated at SRC team functions - i.e. practice, regattas, meetings, etc.
- When at away regattas/events, leave everything in a condition in which you found it. Don't leave a mess anywhere (at a rowing venue, on a plane, hotel room, etc.).
